

Basic Instructor's Course Overview

- The 4 hour course will consist of 2.5 hours of Classroom Instruction and 1.5 hours of Field Demonstrations.
- Classroom Instruction topics will include: The Need for Treestand Safety, Purpose of TMA & Its Role, Training Aids-Classroom & Field Days, Training Equipment & Equipment Purchase Program, Treestand Safety Curriculums, Current Treestand Safety Principals, & Written Test.
- Field Demonstrations will include: Presenters will demonstrate Safe use of Full Body Safety Harness, Suspension Relief, Recovery & Proper use of Full Body Safety Harness with Climber, Ladder, and Hang-on type treestands.
- Instructors who successfully complete the course will be certified by TMA to teach Treestand Safety in Hunter Education classes. Instructor's will also receive a Certified Treestand Safety Instructor's Patch and a Certificate of Completion acknowledging 4 Continuing Education Units.



Certified Trainer's Course Overview

- The 8 hour course will consist of 4 hours of Classroom Instruction and 4 hours of Field Demonstrations & Proficiencies.
- Classroom Instruction topics will include: The Need for Treestand Safety, Purpose of TMA & Its Role, Training Aids-Classroom & Field Days, Training Equipment & Equipment Purchase Program, Treestand Safety Curriculums, Current Treestand Safety Principals, & Written Test.
- Field Demonstrations & Proficiencies will include: Students will demonstrate Safe use of Full Body Safety Harness, Suspension Relief, Recovery & Proper use of Full Body Safety Harness with Climber, Ladder, and Hang-on type treestands.
- Instructors who successfully complete the course will be certified by TMA to teach Treestand Safety in Hunter Education classes and also to train other Instructors. Instructor's will also receive a Certified Treestand Safety Instructor's Patch with Certified Trainer Rocker and a Certificate of Completion acknowledging 8 Continuing Education Units.
